

Biden's Plan for War

How the Biden Administration is planning for war to guarantee the 2024 general election.

No President has ever lost a re-election during a wartime effort. James Madison was re-elected during the War of 1812, Lincoln during the Civil War in 1864, Franklin D. Roosevelt during World War II in 1944, Lyndon B. Johnson during Vietnam in 1964 as well as Richard Nixon in 1972, and George W. Bush in 2004 with Afghanistan and Iraq wars/conflicts. Even Donald Trump wanted war with Iran. Since the United States did not enter into a war with Iran, Donald Trump only served one term. A wartime President has always been re-elected. Will Joseph R. Biden be added to the list?

Biden's plan as I see it.

Let us start with H.R. 4350 - National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2022. This bill authorizes military activities for the Department of Defense, for military construction, and for defense activities for the Department of Energy. This allows for the procurement of AH-64E Apache helicopters, UH-60M Black Hawk helicopters, and so forth. Subtitle B under Title I-Procurement covers

the Army. Subtitle C the Navy. Subtitle D the Air Force. I suggest reading the entire bill if you would like a clearer picture. May I also suggest reading the Amendments to this bill. This will enlighten you to all of the other countries the United States will be entering, building, and sending our military forces.

The next bill, H.R.6119-Further Extending Government Funding Act. Let me give you the back story on this bill first. I have read every bill introduced to the House by the 117th Congress. When this bill came up on October 2nd 2021, it did not have a summary as to what the bill was about. I set an alert to be notified on any changes. On October 3rd 2021, it was passed into law, without a summary. My next notification came on October 17th 2021. The summary.

This bill increases funding for the military. This bill designates \$4 billion dollars for overseas Humanitarian, Disaster, and Civic Aid... for a military base we are building for our troops in Afghanistan. Yes, the United States is going back to Afghanistan. Amendments S.Amdt.4870 and S.Amdt.4869 describe what the real motivation of the United States is...Iran. The United States is going back to Afghanistan under the guise of humanitarian purposes. We are going in locked and loaded. This is what our government does.

I could go into other related bills, such as H.R. 5454 which is related to Chinese military companies, or H.R. 5403 related to mandatory training on the health effects of perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substances. Look them up. Google them. PFAS are manmade chemicals usually used in nonstick cookware and food packaging. Why would the Department of Defense require training on PFAS? Bill H.R. 6169 has the Secretary of Defense discussing the defense of our supply chain. S.2073 is the Taiwan Defense Act of 2021. S.1366, H.R. 4397, H.R. 5158, S.2792, H.R. 6089 (the Stop Iranian Drones Act).

Still, if you are unsure of the deception the government propagates, think about this. The United States is going into Burma (H.R. 5497 Burma Act of 2021) for humanitarian reasons. Those who do not know, Burma (Myanmar) is a Southeast Nation bordering India, Bangladesh, China, Laos, and Thailand. We are going in under the false pretenses of crimes against humanity resulting in genocide. The United States was found guilty on five counts of crimes against humanity directed at Black, Brown, and Indigenous Peoples resulting in genocide on October 25th by an International Tribunal (tribunal2021.com). The very same crimes the United States is guilty of perpetrating upon its own people, is the same reason the United States bullies its way into other countries.

The real reason for going into so many countries under the guise of humanitarian purposes is to gain a military footing for war. Once engaged, Biden will be re-elected. The people will be told to support the war because it is for humanitarian reasons and most will believe the propaganda. This is politics. This is about resources, money, and power. The United States does not care about its people and progress, it only cares about corporate power. This is not left or right. You only think it is.
